Acts 1:12-26

INTRODUCTION: Jesus begins His Heavenly ministry.

- <u>**1:12**</u> -1^{st} step is <u>OBEDIENCE</u> to <u>**1:4**</u>.
- After salvation, there's a "walk" Romans 6:4, Ephesians 4:1
- <u>**1:14</u>** They were <u>BUSY</u> ... didn't get "comfortable".</u>

1.- <u>They PRAYED</u> – <u>1:14</u> - "prayer" and "supplication".

- <u>1:15</u> - Many had followed Jesus – <u>Luke 10:1, 10:17</u>

2.- <u>They Examined The SCRIPTURES</u> – <u>1:16</u>

- God's plan will be accomplished ... with or without us.
- <u>1:17</u> From <u>Psalm 41:9</u>.
- <u>1:18-19</u> A description of the suicide of Judas.
- The Spirit would bring these to their remembrance John 14:26

3.- <u>They GOT TO WORK</u> - <u>1:21</u>

- "Therefore" They wanted to fill the vacancy left by Judas.
- They wanted a "quick fix" to the problem ... see <u>1:6</u>

They acted in the flesh ... this wasn't God's will.

- 1 **PAUL was supposed to be the** *"12th Apostle"* Rev. 21:14
 - Galatians 1:1 They should have waited on Jesus.
- 1 Look at the CRITERION 1:21-22
 - This was THEIR criterion, not Jesus' criterion 2 Tim. 1:11
- 2 <u>They COULDN'T DECIDE</u> <u>1:23</u>
 - God doesn't do things $\frac{1}{2}$ way.

3 They weren't FILLED with the Holy Spirit yet

- It wasn't their job to fill the vacancy -2 Timothy 1:11
- The majority isn't always right.
- 4 <u>They CAST LOTS</u> <u>1:26</u>
 DIFFERENT from <u>Joshua 18:10</u> & <u>1 Chronicles 24:5</u>

5 Matthias WON, Joseph LOST – 1:26

- Jesus already had His man ... PAUL!
- Paul fulfilled <u>Acts 1:8</u>.

<u>CONCLUSION</u>: When you pray, be open to do God's will, God's

way, in God's time.

- Don't settle for God's 2nd best in your life.
