## Acts 4:1-12

## **INTRODUCTION:** Every Christian has a <u>DESIRE</u> to witness.

- Your faith says "Go!", but your fear says "No!".
- **4:1-2** "as they spoke" Peter's sermon is interrupted.
  - Sadducees <u>4:6</u> ... <u>3:15</u>, <u>3:26</u>
- 4:3 "custody" Sanhedrin was the Supreme Court 4:5-6
  - When you speak about Christ, there will be opposition.
  - Being a Christian isn't supposed to be easy!
  - "already evening" Night trials were illegal.
  - We don't witness because of FEAR of the unknown.
- **4:4** "*However*" Persecution only strengthened the Church.
  - Was the persecution worth it? 2:41, 2:47, 4:4
- 4:5 "it came to pass" Look to ETERNITY!
- <u>4:7</u> See <u>3:3</u>, <u>3:16</u> Mosaic Law <u>Deuteronomy 13:1-5</u>
  - "Fear" sees the obstacles, "faith" sees the opportunities.
- 4:8 "filled with the Holy Spirit" 1 indwelling, many fillings.
  - Jesus said they would need this <u>Lk. 21:12-15</u>, <u>Jn. 14:26</u>
  - Rely on the Holy Spirit in your witnessing.
  - If Peter can be "filled with the Holy Spirit", so can you -4:13
  - "Before we can be a witness for God, we must first walk with God."
- <u>4:9-10</u> Peter's only responsibility was to tell them about Jesus.
  - "whom God raised from the dead" Jesus is ALIVE!
  - Peter later wrote 1 Peter 3:15.
  - To be a bold witness, let others know from the start that you're
  - a Christian 3:6, 3:13, 4:10 ... 4;13
- <u>4:11</u> <u>John 14:26</u> You have to <u>KNOW</u> the Scriptures before you can <u>REMEMBER</u> them!
- 4:12 Jonah 2:9b "Salvation is of the LORD".
  - "no other name" Romans 10:13 ... John 14:6
  - God doesn't make any <u>EXCEPTIONS</u> 4:12
  - Do you believe this verse?

## **CONCLUSION:**

- We just <u>ASSUME</u> others don't want to hear what we have to tell them.
- A bold witness comes from the Holy Spirit 4:8, 4:12, 4:31
