INTRODUCTION: Naaman was Captain of the Syrian Army.

- **2 Kings 5:1** Naaman was a great man, but a leper.
 - "Leprosy" is a picture of SIN in the Bible Romans 3:23
 - Leprosy was incurable by human means ... so is SIN.
 - You can try to "cover it up", but only God can CURE it.
- 5:2 She made the best out of a bad situation.
 - Life's problems are here for a PURPOSE.
 - God won't judge you by how <u>GREAT</u> you were.
- **5:3** She knew someone who could "cure" Naaman.
- <u>5:4</u>, <u>5:5-6</u> He figured it must be the King of Israel.
- 1 You can't buy a "cure" for SIN
- 2 He went to the wrong person.
- <u>5:7</u> The King of Israel thought it was a trap.
- **5:8** Elisha knew the "Great Physician".
- **5:9-10** This wasn't the "treatment" Naaman was expecting.
- **5:11** Naaman had his own idea about what he wanted done.
 - People have their own ideas on how to be saved.
 - Few will admit they're sinful enough to go to Hell.
- <u>5:12</u> <u>WHY</u> ... "7 times"? <u>Leviticus 4:6</u>
 - There's no other way to be saved, other than God's way!
- <u>**5:13**</u> People want to do something <u>GREAT</u> to be saved.
- <u>**5:14**</u> Only God's way <u>WORKS</u> <u>Proverbs 14:12</u>, <u>Jn. 14:6</u>
 - Jesus, isn't the way most want to be saved $\underline{Mt. 7:13-14}$
 - Some people only want to go "part way" for salvation.

CONCLUSION:

- 1 PRIDE ... was standing in Naaman's way.
- 2 It took <u>LEPROSY</u> to overcome his pride.
- 2 <u>OBEDIENCE</u> led him to be cleansed of his leprosy.
- If you haven't been "changed", then you haven't been saved.
