INTRODUCTION: God splits Israel because of Solomon's <u>SINS</u>. - Israel breaks from Judah because of Rehoboam's pride, greed.

- 8.- <u>To Protect Someone</u> <u>Psalm 116:11</u>

<u>1 Kings 13:1-5</u> – A young Prophet speaks against the false altars.

- <u>12:2</u> Josiah, 300 years later, would destroy the false priesthood.
- Ashes fallen on the ground made them "unclean".
- To <u>NOT</u> worship the 1 True God, is living a <u>LIE</u> <u>John 4:24</u>
- <u>12:28-29</u> King Jeroboam erected golden calves as false gods.
- <u>12:27</u> He didn't want people to go to Jerusalem to worship.
- <u>12:28-31</u> He set up a false priesthood.
- **13:6** Jeroboam asks the Prophet for God to heal his withered hand.
- **<u>13:7-10</u>** The Prophet is invited to dine with the King … he declines.
- 13:18-19 The older Prophet LIES to him, and he falls for it.
- **<u>13:20-22</u>** There's a consequence to <u>DISOBEDIENCE</u>.
- 13:23-24 He should have sought the Lord on this matter ... FIRST!
 - <u>13:22b</u> To not be buried with ancestors, was a disgrace.
 - $\underline{13:24} 2$ "un-natural" events ... the beasts were <u>OBEDIENT</u>.

- 2 Beware of "2nd Hand" Information Prov. 14:12, Prov. 3:5
- 2 <u>Rely On God's Word</u> <u>2 Timothy 4:3-4</u>, <u>Acts 17:11</u>
