<u>NAAMAN</u> – "The Rest Of The Story"

INTRODUCTION: Naaman was healed of leprosy – <u>2 Kings 5:14</u>

- <u>5:15</u> Naaman offers Elisha gifts <u>5:6</u>
- 5:16 Elisha refuses Naaman's gifts ... he wanted <u>GOD</u> to be seen in the miracle, not Elisha.
- 5:17 Naaman wanted *"dirt"*, so he could set up a place of worship
- in Syria, to worship Jehovah God ... he was a "changed" man.
- <u>5:18</u> Naaman was obligated to accompany his King to the false worship ceremonies of the god of his King.
 - We can't *"isolate"* ourselves from the world <u>1 Thess. 5:22</u>
- 5:19 Naaman leaves Elisha ... in "peace".
- 5:20 Gehazi is Elisha's servant ... seen in <u>Chapter 4</u>. - <u>GREED</u> ... enters into Gehazi's heart.
 - Gehazi could probably <u>JUSTIFY</u> his actions.
- <u>5:21-22</u> Gehazi is <u>LYING</u> to Naaman, but Naaman is glad to give to Elisha's ministry.
- 5:23 Naaman is being generous ... about 150# of <u>SILVER</u> <u>5:5</u>
 Gehazi didn't want to appear too greedy ... it was pre-meditated.
- <u>5:24</u> Gehazi want to hide the "loot".
 If you have to "hide" something from someone, is it usually the right thing to do?
- 5:25 Servants were dismissed by the Master, and Elisha hadn't dismissed Gehazi.
 - Gehazi lies to Elisha ... trying not to get caught!
- <u>5:26</u> Gehazi gets caught in his lie ... Elisha knows what Gehazi <u>WANTS TO DO</u> with the *"loot"*.
 God is Omniscient ... He's always watching ...
 - He always KNOWS ... you can't fool GOD ...

you don't get away with anything!

5:27 – There's a punishment for the crime ... and, it's *"passed down"*, affecting future generations – <u>1 Timothy 6:10</u>

CONCLUSION:

- Is it worth it ... to be <u>UN-TRUE</u>, <u>TRUE</u> ... to God?
- It's better to walk with God, than with Satan.
