## "Jesus Teaches About Repentance"

**INTRODUCTION:** John the Baptizer preached about

REPENTANCE ... Luke 3:3,

Luke 3:8

Luke 13:1-5 – Repentance is essential for salvation.

13:1 – They relate a "current event" to Jesus – Acts 5:37

13:2 – Jews thought all suffering was the result of sin.

13:4 – Jesus brings up another "current event".

- 1 More troubles don't mean you're a greater sinner.
- 2 Good Christians aren't "*immune*" to troubles.
- 3 You're no better than those who have more troubles
- 4 You'd be in BIG trouble if it was due to personal sin Rom. 3:10

5 You don't know when you'll die, so <u>BE READY</u>!

- 13:3, 13:5 Jesus' <u>RESPONSE</u> to these "current events".
  - A lack of <u>REPENTANCE</u> will cause you to <u>PERISH</u>.
  - Jesus on <u>REPENTANCE</u> ... <u>Mt. 4:17</u>, <u>Mk. 1:14-15</u>, <u>Lk. 46-47</u>

## "ACCEPT Jesus as your Lord and Savior." "ACCEPT" WHAT?

- You can "accept" all the right & true things, and still be LOST.
- Your "head" can be CONVERTED, but not your "heart".
- Just <u>AGREEING</u> with the truth, won't <u>SAVE</u> you <u>Mt. 8:29</u>

## <u>WHAT IS "REPENTANCE"</u>? "to feel <u>compunction</u>" ... 'a strong uneasiness caused by a sense of guilt or remorse".

- 1 <u>REPENTANCE</u> is seeing your sin the same way God sees it ... and seeing yourself as a sinner the same way God sees you.
- 2 <u>REPENTANCE</u> is having a broken heart because of what your sin
- 3 did to Jesus on the cross -2 Corinthians 7:10
- 2 <u>REPENTANCE</u> is an ugly "*picture*", when we look at the ugliness of our sin, and compare it to God's holiness.

AN ILLUSTRATION of how our sin affects God ...

- Without repentance, there is no salvation Ps. 51:3-4
- What does a <u>LACK</u> of repentance tell Jesus?
- What does repentance tell Jesus?
- Have you truly REPENTED of your sins?
