"Heroes Of The Faith" - SAMSON

- INTRODUCTION: Rahab? Gideon? Barak? Samson? Heb. 11:32
 - We aren't much different from Samson ... in many ways.
- <u>Judges 13:1</u> Sin, Servitude, Supplication, Salvation, Silence ... To break the cycle ... 1 John 1:9
- 13:2 Out of "barrenness", God can bring "blessing" ... REPENT.
- 13:3-4 "Commitment" then "blessing" ... Samson is born.
- 13:5 Samson was to be "committed" to the Nazarite Vow for life.
 - Likewise, we're to be "committed" to God Mt. 6:33, 1 Cor. 10:31
- <u>13:24-25</u> Physically he was strong, but spiritually he was weak.
- 14:1-3 Samson wants a Philistine wife ... forbidden by God.
 - Though saved, we're still attracted to the world ... we fraternize too much with the Enemy ... "insulation", not "isolation".

How do you know when your life becomes "worldly"?

1You begin to "value" what they "value".

2They have more influence over you, than you do over them.

2There's no difference between your/their behavior.

- <u>14:5-6, 7-9</u> Feats of Samson's strength ... he broke his <u>Nazarite Vow</u> ... 14:19 ... 15:14-15.
 - God, is a God of grace, love, mercy, forgiveness ... He's patient.
 - Samson had a problem with <u>PRIDE</u> ... foxes ... City Gates ... he liked to antagonize the Philistines ... to "show off".
- <u>16:4-5</u> Delilah is hired to find out Samson's source of strength.
 - There was no evidence of "muscles", or a "man of God".
- 16:15-17 Delilah "nagged" the secret out of Samson!
 - Samson's hair was a visual reminder of his commitment to God.
- **16:20** − 1 of the saddest verses in the Bible!
 - Samson cut his ties with God, and God's power.
- <u>16:21</u> God's not through with Samson ... <u>16:22</u> ... Satan can "cut your hair", but he can't take away the "roots"!
- 16:28 Samson repents and prays to God for strength 16:29-30

CONCLUSION: <u>LESSONS</u> from Samson ...

- Don't let the world corrupt you ... Don't waste your strength ... God is the God of the "2nd chance".
- Samson came back to God ... God never "gave up" on him.
