### <u>KINGS OF ISRAEL</u> – <u>SOLOMON</u> – IV

**INTRODUCTION:** - Solomon had everything going for him. 1 Kings 4:32-34 — Solomon was blessed by God.

- 11:1-2 Solomon disobeyed God's commands.
  - Satan glorifies the "forbidden fruit".
- <u>11:3</u> Solomon purposely chose <u>FOREIGN</u> women.
  - Solomon thought he could handle it, God knew he couldn't.
- <u>11:4</u> You can't serve 2 masters <u>Matthew 6:24</u>, <u>Joshua 24:12</u>
  - Solomon's sin was a GRADUAL process.

## <u>11:5-6</u> – "did not fully follow the LORD" – <u>COMPROMISE</u> ...

#### 2 Corinthians 6:17

- We think it could never happen to <u>US!</u> But we get accustomed, calloused, immune to Satan's influence.
- Solomon was <u>ARROGANT</u> ... he thought God's rules applied to everyone else, but not to him ... he was blind to the <u>COST</u>.
- Do we think God's rules don't apply to US? 2 Cor. 6:14-15
- Solomon pretended not to hear God, when He spoke Proverbs 15:31, Ecclesiastes 9:17
- <u>11:7-8</u> Solomon spent time with the wrong people <u>Psalm 1:1-2</u>
  - "Choose your friends wisely ... you become what they are."
- 11:9-13 The RESULT of Solomon's sins.
  - Solomon robbed his son of a great inheritance.

# <u>Exodus 20:5-6</u> – Both the <u>CURSE</u> and the <u>BLESSING</u> can affect future generations.

- Sometimes WE pay for our sins, sometimes our FAMILY pays.
- We can provide an "Umbrella Of Blessing" for our family.

#### **CONCLUSION:**

- If you play with sin, you're going to get HURT.
- The COST is always more than the PLEASURE ... Matthew 6:33
