INTRODUCTION:

-

- Choose your battles ... know your real enemy.
- Remember God's victories 1 Samuel 17:33-36
- 17:37 Saul gives David an "empty cliché".
- 17:38-39 What works for somebody else, might not work for you.
 - Don't try to imitate someone else ... if God's given you a sword, use it ... if God's given you a sling-shot, use it.
- <u>17:40</u> Trust God, and He'll win the battle ... it's <u>HIS BATTLE!</u>
- <u>17:41-47</u> David's eyes were on God, not the giant.
 - Don't try to fight your "giant" in the FLESH.
- <u>17:48-50</u> Goliath had 4 sons <u>2 Samuel 21:20-22</u>
- <u>17:50-51</u> Was Goliath killed by the stone, or the sword?
 - What the Philistines $\underline{DID} \underline{17:51b}$ cp.- $\underline{SAID} \underline{17:9}$
- <u>17:52-53</u> Israel chased them ... took trophies <u>17:54-57</u>
 - The Philistines take trophies of their own -31:8-10
- **18:6-7** David becomes a "hero" **18:2,5**
- 18:8-9 Saul becomes JEALOUS of David.
- <u>JEALOUSY</u> makes you do terrible things <u>James 3:16</u>, <u>Proverbs 14:30</u>
- <u>JEALOUSY</u> is seen in ... Lucifer ... Cain & Abel ... Joseph's brothers ... Elder Son.
- The antidote for jealousy Phil. 4:12-13 CONTENTMENT.
- Focusing on God brings <u>CONTENTMENT</u>.
- God is "jealous" ... it's His name Exodus 34:14, Exodus 20:3-4
- Nothing has priority over God ... He has no rivals ... so God can be righteously *"jealous"*.
- Jealousy when Christians flirted with the world 2 Cor. 11:2
- The Father is "jealous" when cheat on His Son 1 Cor. 10:21-22
- It's not wise to make Almighty God JEALOUS!

CONCLUSION:

- Use what God has given you ... don't try to be anybody else.
- God made you "special", and has a special ministry for you.
- Your "giant" is no comparison to your GOD 17:47
